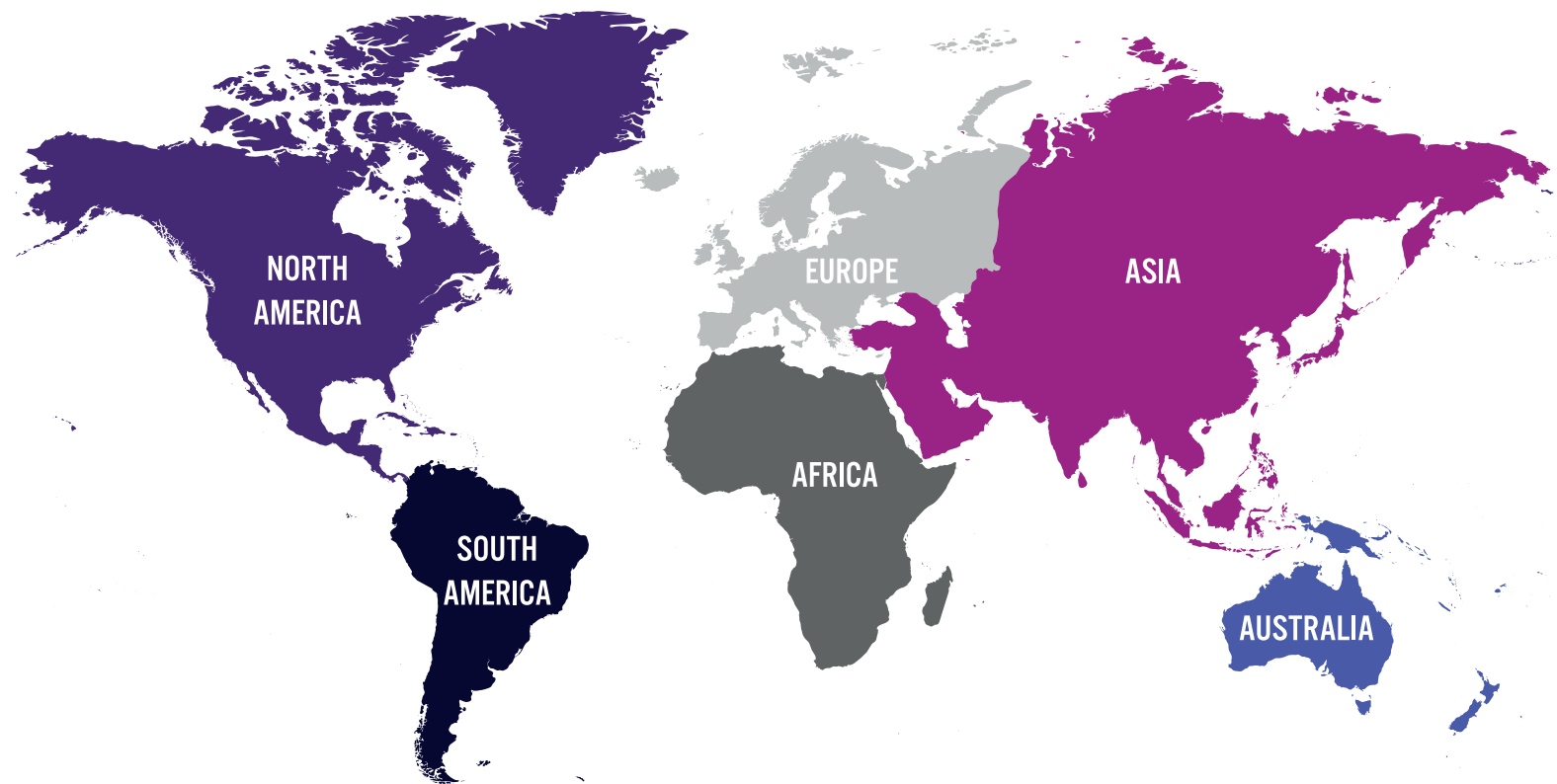

5. Hong Kong

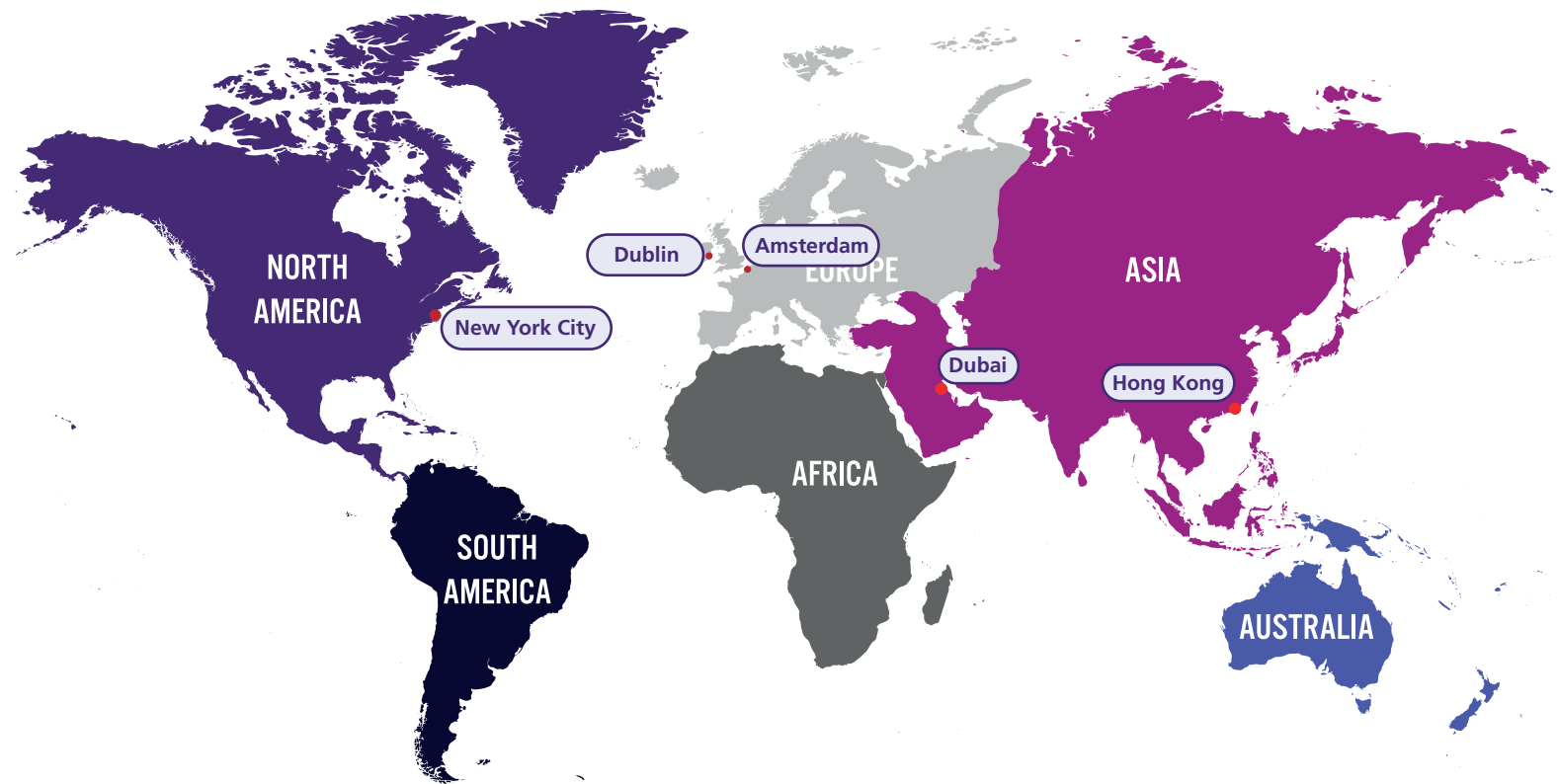
Looking at the blank map below can you point out where each of these destinations are?

1. New York City

a) Situated in the United States of America

b) Example landmarks: The Statue of Liberty, Empire State Building, Brooklyn Bridge

2. Dubai

a) Situated in the United Arab Emirates

b) Example landmarks: Burj Khalifa, Palm Jumeirah, Al Sahara Desert

3. Dublin

a) Situated in Ireland

b) Example landmarks: The Spire, Guinness Storehouse, Samuel Beckett Bridge

4. Amsterdam

a) Situated in the Netherlands

b) Example landmarks: Rijksmuseum, Canals of Amsterdam, Anne Frank House

5. Hong Kong

a) Situated in China

b) Example landmarks: Victoria Peak, The Big Buddha, Junk Boats in Victoria Harbour
