This part is all about your character – put them in the spotlight! Start by introducing this person in your community – who are they? What do they want or need?

Example: Owen loves playing sports, it's his favourite thing to do (especially basketball). Owen is in a wheelchair and his family has recently moved to Springston. He really wants to make new friends by joining a sports club.

Here it is: the big problem.

How does the problem affect your character? What is it stopping them from doing?

Example: Owen's local sports centre doesn't have wheelchair access. This is making Owen feel lonely and he feels like he's missing out.

Ta-dah! It's time to share your sensational solution.

How can you fix the problem in your community? What is your big idea?

Example: A brand new sports centre that is an inclusive space for everyone (no matter their ability) to enjoy sports and make friends.
