## What do I need to do?

In class, you've used your imagination to build something that'll help your community thrive. That's amazing! The work you've made will tell us the story of how you'd tackle **loneliness, waste or the regeneration of nature** in your community.

## I'm in! How do I enter?

To enter the Community Challenge Competition, you'll need an adult to submit your film for you. Talk to your teacher, or an adult in your family if you've created your film away from school.

## Grown ups, this bit's for you:

1. Scan the QR code on the right, or click [here](#).
2. Fill out the form with pupils' names and other details.
3. Upload the film (you'll need to fill in a form for each film created).
4. Upload a consent form for each child involved in making the film, signed by a parent or legal guardian. You can download the consent form [here](#).

## How will the competition be judged?

We only have three criteria.

1. Meaningful (you'll tell a brilliant story to inspire positive change)
2. Creative (we want to see that you've used your imagination to have an impact on the community)
3. Effective (expresses your hopes and dreams for the future in a clear, easy-to-follow way, motivating others to share them)
