
Thank you for registering your interest in TfL Discoverers, providing children aged 3-4 with the crucial road safety skills they need for life.


Secondary messages

These three key messages are supported by three secondary messages to ensure kids get road safety right:

- · Always wait for the green person at the crossing.
- Always listen to a trusted adult around traffic.
- · Don't play around when crossing the road.

There's also the added participation of a streetwise song, which children can sing at the beginning and end of the session, to back up what they've learnt. 




