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Top Tips for keeping teeth bright and healthy



1. Brush twice a day with fluoride toothpaste for at least 2 minutes

2. Make sure that every surface of every tooth is brushed thoroughly – front, back, top and sides

3. Use different brush strokes – up and down, side to side and round in circles

4. Don't forget to brush your tongue and gums



5. Brush in front of a mirror so you can see what you're doing and make sure every tooth gets attention

6. Spit out the toothpaste but don't rinse your mouth

THE COMPETITION!

Primary school children across the UK and Ireland have been sent an urgent plea for help from the Shine Bright Academy (A magical school where tooth guardians are trained and Terrific Teeth Teams are celebrated).

For example, they might remind each member about key parts of the teeth cleaning process such as flossing, or make sure the bathroom cupboard is stocked up with the right toothpaste for everyone. To help with their search, the Shine Bright Academy is asking children to submit their own Terrific Teeth Teams.



The competition is open to all Primary school pupils (aged 4-7) across the UK and ROI.

Your task

Using the competition entry form on page 4, inspire your child to think of their own Terrific Teeth Team.

They will need to:

- Task 1 Think of a name for their Terrific Teeth Team. It could be related to where they live or how they brush. The name could rhyme or use alliteration to make it creative and unique. For example, The Bromley Brushers, The Dagenham Dazzlers or The Foxbury Road Flossers.
- Task 2 Design a logo for their team and draw a picture of each member. The logo needs to be bold, colourful and contain the team name. They could draw each member holding the important things they use to encourage everyone's healthy habits such as floss or a timer.
- Task 3 Explain how each member of the team helps to keep each other's teeth dazzlingly bright! Write a sentence about each member explaining why each of them are really important. For example, Granny Shirley always reminds her team to brush their teeth before bed, Papa Tom always makes sure the team is stocked up on toothpaste and Little Jenny uses her stopwatch to make sure everyone brushes their teeth for 2 minutes!
