...it costs less money to recycle glass than to take it to landfill.

...bottles and jars are the easiest materials to recycle.

...bottles and jars can be recycled over and over again and they will still be as good as new!

...lots of glass is still not being recycled - what a waste!

...recycling just 2 glass jars saves the same amount of energy needed to heat your oven to bake a cake!

...ALL glass bottles and jars can be recycled!

...your empty glass jars and bottles can be taken away, recycled, made into new ones and be back in the shops in just 30 days!

... using recycled glass is better for our planet as it doesn't give off as much CO2 gasses which are bad for the environment
